Battle of the Buildings Competition is an energy saving competition among Town owned and operated buildings to challenge facility users to cumulatively reduce electricity and natural gas consumption by at least 10%.

This effort directly supports the Town of Ajax's corporate goal of reducing greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions by 20% below 2019 levels by the end of 2025.

 Ajax Main Library Branch


The Town's energy management software, EnergyCAP dashboard, will monitor energy performance progress of participating buildings. The winning building and its team will be recognized and awarded.

The intent of this competition is to inspire, educate, and motivate facility users to:

- Raise awareness, and take ownership, of each facility's utility consumption and associated costs
- Engage and educate staff and residents on their environmental impact at public facilities.
- Identify and implement low-cost/no-cost operational improvements.
- Share operational best practices among similar facilities.
- Recognize and reward individuals that take the initiative towards continuous improvement.
- Promote cost savings by decreasing energy consumption and GHG emissions.
